Directive on Procedures for Appointment of Health Civil Servants

The Ministry of Health has previously observed that all provincial-municipal health departments has well carried out promotion power and duty revision for their subordinate civil servants, based on letter No. 1210 &J.ÄUÄ, dated July 12, 1994 and circular No. 190 &J.ÄUÄ, dated December 13, 1994, of the Health Ministry. However, from now on to be in compliance with circular No. 02 &JIMAS, dated March 15, 1999 and circular No. 10 &JIMAS, dated June 28, 1999, of the Royal Government on procedures for appointment of civil servants, the Ministry of Health would like to instruct all provincial-municipal health departments as follows:

1. Appointment Power and Competence:

- A. Functions and positions of civil servants to be appointed by Prakas of Ministry of Health include:
 - Heads-deputy heads of operational district health offices and equivalents
 - Heads-deputy heads of offices within departments
- B. Functions and positions of civil servants to be appointed by decisions of Ministry of Health
 - Heads-deputy heads of health posts
 - Heads-deputy heads of health centers
 - Deputy heads of referral hospitals
- C. Functions and positions of civil servants to be appointed by assignment letters of operational district offices include:
 - Heads-deputy heads of units within referral hospitals
 - Heads-deputy heads of units within operational district offices
 - Heads-deputy heads of units within heath centers and posts

2. Appointment Procedures:

- The appointment of civil servants stated in point 1 shall be done in conformity with the organizational chart and structure of the unit.
- With regard to the appointment of civil servants stipulated in 1A, provincial-municipal health departments shall raise proposals to the ministry in an administrative hierarchy, enclosing applications as in the appendix attached to the directive.

- With respect to the appointment of civil servants stated in 1B and 1C, the unit of the concerned persons shall also raise proposals to appointment-competent levels in a hierarchy.
- Qualifications of the concerned persons to be proposed for appointment:
 - Have specialized certificates suitable for proposed positions
 - Have achievements and successive related work experience
 - Have had performed duties and gained trust from higher levels and support from lower levels, and have taken responsibility
 - Have a good morality of communicating with higher and lower levels and be a good example on all areas of social conduct
- 3. In respect of civil servants with functions and positions as stated in 1A and really holding the positions within the organizational chart and structure of provincial-municipal health departments, the provincial-municipal health departments shall raise proposals to the Ministry of Health for examination and decision-making.

Having received the directive, all provincial-municipal health departments shall try to carry out the directive with responsibility and high effectiveness.
