Previously, MoH has noticed that some ambulances including private clinics' ambulances and disguising ambulances without proper plate numbers have transported injured victims of road traffic collision to their respective clinics or run other illegal businesses by using ambulances with disguised Red-Cross symbols and loud sirens.

As explained herein, MoH wishes to request the collaboration from H.E. National Police General Commissioner and H.E Deputy Commander-in-Chief to impound those illegal ambulances, which do not comply with the circular and take legal action accordingly.
